### **Six Ohio businesses cited over the weekend for violating health orders**

Six Ohio businesses, including one in the Tri-State area, were cited overnight Sunday after state officials received several complaints of violating state health orders.

The citations come after Gov. Mike DeWine issued several health orders including a statewide mask mandate and a halt on alcohol sales after 10 p.m.

Officials said the businesses were cited for things like disorderly activity, employees not wearing facial coverings, unsanitary conditions and serving alcohol after 10 p.m.

Wayne County Speedway received a citation after holding an event over the weekend.

Agents, along with the health department, said they found several health violations, like employees not wearing facial coverings. The OIU issued a violation notice against the liquor permit for improper conduct – disorderly activity. The health department issued additional violations relating to people attending the event. Those violations will be handled by the health department, OIU said.

Moose Lodge, in Waverly, was cited after agents entered the business around 12:30 a.m. and saw customers drinking beer. The agents then conducted an administrative inspection and found an additional violation for unsanitary conditions.

Kings Grill in Lebanon received a citation after agents entered the grill and were able to buy beer at 10:45 p.m., after the 10 p.m. time restriction issued by the governor.

Laynes Lounge in New Carlisle received a citation after agents were able to buy beer at 10:45 p.m. and again at 11:15 p.m., after the 10 p.m. time restriction.

Hotwired Restaurant Group LLC, known as Tempe Taco in Reynoldsburg, received a citation after a complaint was made indicating customers were able to buy more than three mixed drinks to go without

buying food. Agents visited the business and were able to purchase four alcoholic drinks for off-premises consumption.

Burnzies Old Trail Inn LLC, known as Burnzie's Old Trail, Columbus, received a citation after agents visited the business and were able to purchase a beer from the bar at 10:30 p.m., after the 10 p.m. time restriction.

These cases will go before the Ohio Liquor Control Commission for potential penalties, including fines and/or the suspension or revocation of liquor permits.

"The majority of establishments we visit are doing everything they can to provide a safe environment for their patrons," said OIU Enforcement Commander Eric Wolf. "It is no surprise to see so many following the precautions put in place to make their establishments safe and compliant with the directives. Agents will continue to conduct compliance checks and take enforcement action when egregious violations are observed."

### **Trump fires TVA chairman, cites hiring of foreign workers**

President Donald Trump said Monday that he had fired the chairman of the Tennessee Valley Authority, criticizing the federally owned corporation for hiring foreign workers to replace IT workers in Chattanooga and other TVA cities.

Trump told reporters at the White House that he was formally removing TVA chairman James "Skip" Thompson and former TVA Chairman Richard Howorth from the nine-member board, and he threatened to remove other TVA board members if they continued to hire foreign labor.

Thompson, a Decatur, Alabama businessman appointed to the post by Trump in 2017, was elected TVA board chairman last year and disagreed with President Trump in April over his criticism of TVA and its CEO, Jeff Lyash.

Trump, who previously denounced the \$8.1 million compensation package given to Lyash as "ridiculous," also called upon the TVA board to replace Lyash and immediately hire a new chief executive officer who "puts the interests of Americans first."

"The new CEO must be paid no more than \$500,000 a year," Trump said. "We want the TVA to take action on this immediately. ... Let this serve as a warning to any federally appointed board: If you betray American workers, you will hear two words: 'You're fired.'"

## FAKE MEAT

[This veggie burger bleeds, looks & tastes like real meat](#)



As Ron Swanson has proved time and time again, it's tough to beat a hamburger, on a bun, with nothing. But veggie burgers are now getting damn close to that meaty ideal, thanks to a new advance by Impossible Foods: a veggie burger that looks and tastes like a real, medium-rare beef patty. Chris Traeger, eat your heart out.

Based on research conducted by Stanford professor and Impossible Foods founder Patrick Brown, the as-yet unnamed veggie burger has a flavor somewhere between turkey and real beef, and is made out of amino acids and fats that come from plants rather than animals. It's also got an extremely similar consistency to meat, and contains juices derived from molecules found in hemoglobin -- the stuff in blood that makes it red.

With no cholesterol or meat-induced comas after eating, it's possible that this is the vegan-friendly burger of the future. And keep your eyes peeled, because they're also working on vegan versions of cheese and eggs. Could they convert even the staunchest carnivores? No word yet from Mr. Swanson.

#### [U.S. agrees to pay Pfizer and BioNTech \\$2 billion for 100 million doses of coronavirus vaccine](#)

The U.S. will pay Pfizer and biotech firm BioNTech \$1.95 billion to produce and deliver 100 million doses of their Covid-19 vaccine if it proves safe and effective, the companies announced Wednesday.

It was the largest such deal between the government and companies racing to develop a coronavirus vaccine.

Under the agreement, the U.S. can acquire 500 million additional doses, the Department of Health and Human Services said. Germany-based BioNTech and Pfizer are jointly developing four potential vaccines.

If one of the vaccines proves safe and effective in a large phase three trial and receives regulatory approval, HHS said Pfizer will begin to deliver doses to locations across the U.S. at the government's direction. The vaccine would then be made available to Americans "at no cost," HHS said. It's unclear who the first doses of the potential vaccine would go to and how that decision would be made.

The companies previously said they expect to begin a large trial with up to 30,000 participants later this month, if they receive regulatory approval.

Shares of Pfizer were 3.8% higher in early trading Wednesday and BioNTech stock was up 4%.

[Ex-Cardinal Theodore McCarrick Accused Of Running Sex Ring Out Of New Jersey Beach House](#)

Ex-Cardinal Theodore McCarrick has been accused of running a underage sex ring out of his New Jersey beach house.

The victim, identified only as “Doe 14” claimed the sexual abuse began when he was 14 at McCarrick’s beach house in 1982, according to a lawsuit filed Tuesday in the New Jersey Superior Court, the New York Post reported. The victim, now 53, claims he was abused by McCarrick and three other priests.

“In the night, with the assistance of others, McCarrick would creep into this kid’s bed and engage in criminal sexual assault of him, whispering, ‘It is OK,’” attorney for the victim Jeff Anderson said at a press conference.

The other three priests involved were named as Gerald Ruane, Michael Walters and John Laferrera. All three had been previously accused of sexual abuse and exposed when **New Jersey’s Catholic dioceses released 188 names of credibly accused priests in 2019.**

[Grammy-winning producer Detail arrested on 15 sexual assault charges](#)

A Grammy-winning music producer known as Detail has been arrested on 15 sexual assault charges and five additional felony assault-related charges, authorities said Wednesday.

The producer, whose real name is Noel Fisher, was arrested Wednesday by the L.A. County Sheriff's Department and is being investigated for incidents that occurred between 2010 and 2018, the department said in a media release.

According to the Associated Press, in 2019 a model who alleged in a lawsuit that she had been raped and sexually and emotionally abused by Fisher was awarded \$15 million in Los Angeles Superior Court. Fisher, the news agency reported, won a Grammy for co-writing the Beyonce and Jay-Z hit duet "Drunk in Love."
