# GEORGE FLOYD UPDATE

## [George Floyd Case You Killed Him In Front Of Kids!!! Prosecutors Seeking Harsher Sentence](#)

Derek Chauvin -- the ex-Minneapolis cop charged with murdering George Floyd -- deserves an especially harsh sentence because, among other things, he killed Floyd in front of kids ... according to prosecutors.

Minnesota Attorney General Keith Ellison just informed the judge in the Floyd murder case he'll be seeking a harsher sentence for Chauvin, for several reasons.

The AG says the alleged murder was especially heinous because there were a number of children around who had to watch a man die.

In legal docs, obtained by TMZ, Ellison says Floyd was in a "particularly vulnerable" state because he was handcuffed and chest down on the pavement, repeatedly telling Chauvin and the other officers he could not breathe.

Ellison also claims Chauvin treated Floyd with "particular cruelty," by ignoring Floyd's pleas that he couldn't breathe and was going to die. Prosecutors also say Chauvin was heartless because he ignored horrified onlookers, and kept his knee pinned on Floyd's neck for nearly 9 minutes, including 4 minutes where Floyd was motionless.

The AG says the knee to the neck inflicted great pain on Floyd and claims Chauvin did not offer Floyd any medical assistance and discouraged others from doing so while witnesses watched him die.

As we reported ... Chauvin is facing up to 40 years in prison if convicted on his second-degree murder charge. The AG's new docs suggest he'll be going for the max.

# BLACK LIVES MATTER ... BUT SO DO RACING POINTS

**Lewis Hamilton 'stands unified' with boycotting athletes but will race at Belgian GP**



Lewis Hamilton has lauded the "incredible" boycotts of sporting events in the United States after the shooting of Jacob Blake, but said it would achieve little if he did the same at Sunday's Belgian Grand Prix.

On Wednesday evening, three NBA playoff games were postponed after players refused to take to the court. Fixtures in the WNBA, MLB and MLS were also postponed following similar boycotts. Tennis player Naomi Osaka withdrew from a tournament in New York; Hamilton wrote on Instagram that he was "so proud" of her decision.

Asked on Thursday whether he plans a similar protest for the Belgian GP, Hamilton, the only Black F1 driver in the sport's history, said he stands unified with those taking action but that boycotting events was more relevant for American sports.

"Firstly, I think it is incredible what many out there in the States are doing in the sports all the way down to the people that are hosting, commentators for example," he said. "So many people are standing.

"The players are really pushing for change. It's a shame that's what's needed over there to get a reaction.

"But that is in America, and I don't know whether me doing anything here will particularly have any effect. We're in Belgium, we're not in the United States. I haven't spoken to anyone about it, but I am really proud of so many out there, and I do stand unified with them, trying to do what I can over here.

"I don't really know how us not doing the race -- and it would still go on -- is a thing. But as I said, I will try to speak to Formula One to see what else we can do to continue to raise awareness, continue to help push. ... Naturally, as a sport, we need to be aligned and supporting one another, even if it is a different sport."

Hamilton holds a comfortable lead in the F1 drivers' championship, sitting 37 points ahead of Red Bull's Max Verstappen.

# PROCESSED CHICKEN LIKE PRODUCT

**Nebraska man's 'boneless chicken wings' rant goes viral. His ideas for a better name include 'wet tenders' or 'saucy nugls'.**

A Nebraska man has made an impassioned plea to his local city council, chicken vendors and wing connoisseurs everywhere: Please stop using the phrase "boneless chicken wings."

Lincoln resident Ander Christensen brought his hot takes to a city council meeting on Aug. 31, raising his point during the public comments. Christensen's fervent opposition to boneless wings went viral after local radio station KRVN shared his story.

He begins with a proposal to council members to make Lincoln a "social leader" in the country.

"We have been casually ignoring a problem that has gotten so out of control that our children are casually throwing around names and words without even understanding their true meaning," he said.

Despite scattered chuckles from the audience, Christensen continues: "I go into nice family restaurants and I see people throwing this name around and pretending as though everything is just fine," said Christensen. "I'm talking about boneless chicken wings."

He goes on to make a proposal: "I propose that we as a city remove the name boneless wings from our menus and from our hearts," he says.

He explains that boneless chicken wings don't actually come from, well, a wing of a chicken, nor are they remotely similar to their winged brethren. "Boneless chicken wings are just chicken tenders, which are already boneless," he said.

Christensen's final reason? "We need to raise our children better." He explains that children need to know where their chicken comes from, without "fear of bones."

He has a few suggestions for "Buffalo-style chicken tenders," "wet tenders," "saucy nugls," and, finally, "trash."

[U.S. agrees to pay Pfizer and BioNTech \\$2 billion for 100 million doses of coronavirus vaccine](#)

The U.S. will pay Pfizer and biotech firm BioNTech \$1.95 billion to produce and deliver 100 million doses of their Covid-19 vaccine if it proves safe and effective, the companies announced Wednesday.

It was the largest such deal between the government and companies racing to develop a coronavirus vaccine.

Under the agreement, the U.S. can acquire 500 million additional doses, the Department of Health and Human Services said. Germany-based BioNTech and Pfizer are jointly developing four potential vaccines.

If one of the vaccines proves safe and effective in a large phase three trial and receives regulatory approval, HHS said Pfizer will begin to deliver doses to locations across the U.S. at the government's direction. The vaccine would then be made available to Americans "at no cost," HHS said. It's unclear who the first doses of the potential vaccine would go to and how that decision would be made.

The companies previously said they expect to begin a large trial with up to 30,000 participants later this month, if they receive regulatory approval.

Shares of Pfizer were 3.8% higher in early trading Wednesday and BioNTech stock was up 4%.

[Ex-Cardinal Theodore McCarrick Accused Of Running Sex Ring Out Of New Jersey Beach House](#)

Ex-Cardinal Theodore McCarrick has been accused of running a underage sex ring out of his New Jersey beach house.

The victim, identified only as “Doe 14” claimed the sexual abuse began when he was 14 at McCarrick’s beach house in 1982, according to a lawsuit filed Tuesday in the New Jersey Superior Court, the New York Post reported. The victim, now 53, claims he was abused by McCarrick and three other priests.

“In the night, with the assistance of others, McCarrick would creep into this kid’s bed and engage in criminal sexual assault of him, whispering, ‘It is OK,’” attorney for the victim Jeff Anderson said at a press conference.

The other three priests involved were named as Gerald Ruane, Michael Walters and John Laferrera. All three had been previously accused of sexual abuse and exposed when **New Jersey’s Catholic dioceses released 188 names of credibly accused priests in 2019.**

[Grammy-winning producer Detail arrested on 15 sexual assault charges](#)

A Grammy-winning music producer known as Detail has been arrested on 15 sexual assault charges and five additional felony assault-related charges, authorities said Wednesday.

The producer, whose real name is Noel Fisher, was arrested Wednesday by the L.A. County Sheriff's Department and is being investigated for incidents that occurred between 2010 and 2018, the department said in a media release.

According to the Associated Press, in 2019 a model who alleged in a lawsuit that she had been raped and sexually and emotionally abused by Fisher was awarded \$15 million in Los Angeles Superior Court. Fisher, the news agency reported, won a Grammy for co-writing the Beyonce and Jay-Z hit duet "Drunk in Love."

## [Covid: Australian anti-lockdown suspect's arrest draws controversy](#)

The arrest of a woman in Australia for promoting an anti-lockdown protest online has drawn criticism, after video of the incident went viral.

Footage shows officers handcuffing pregnant woman Zoe-Lee Buhler, 28, in her home in Victoria on Wednesday in front of her partner and children.

She starts crying during the arrest, telling police: "I didn't realise I was doing anything wrong."

Authorities have defended the officers, saying they acted appropriately.

Victoria has been in lockdown since July to curb a coronavirus outbreak that has fuelled Australia's second wave.

Authorities have imposed stay-at-home rules and a curfew in Melbourne, the state capital. The lockdown has closed many businesses and banned gatherings around the state.

Many people support the measures but others oppose them, and they have been targeted by a fringe anti-lockdown movement.

Last week Victoria Police warned it would arrest people for organising protests in breach of the ban on gatherings.

### **What happened?**

The video - which was live-streamed on Facebook and has been viewed over two million times - shows Ms Buhler and her partner speaking to police in their home in the city of Ballarat. The Victoria Police officers are seen with a warrant.

When asked what the arrest is about, one officer says: "It's in relation to a Facebook post, in relation to a lockdown protest you put on just that day."

Ms Buhler, who is wearing pyjamas, then offers to delete her post.

"My two kids are here - I have an ultrasound in an hour," she says. "This is ridiculous... I didn't realise I was doing anything wrong."

But the officers respond by telling her she has been charged with "incitement" over a planned protest in Ballarat on Saturday. The event is part of wider anti-lockdown rallies.
