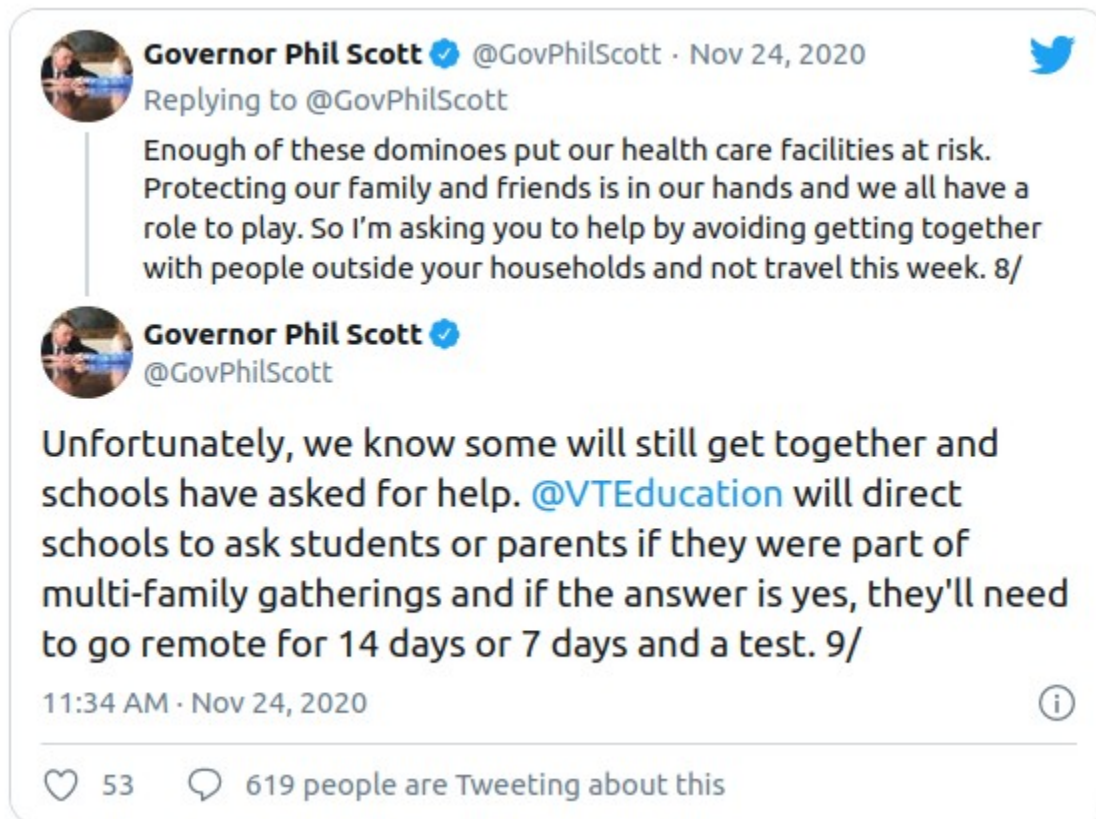

Vermont schools will grill students on their Thanksgiving celebrations, governor announces

Students who attend events with more than just their immediate household will be required to either take online classes for a two-week quarantine period or quarantine for a week and then have a negative COVID-19 test.

Vermont Gov. Phil Scott said during a press conference on Tuesday that schools in the state will include new questions during daily health checks about whether students and their parents attended gatherings outside of their households following the Thanksgiving holiday.



Scott noted that any students who attend events with more than just their immediate household will be required to either take online classes for a two-week quarantine period or quarantine for a week and then have a negative COVID-19 test.

"We understand how difficult this is, but since we know these types of gatherings have been the cause of so many outbreaks, we've got to do all we can to slow this down," Scott said.

The governor also encouraged businesses to take the same approach with their employees.

"From my standpoint, this is fair warning to those of you who are planning to have gatherings from outside your household for Thanksgiving," Scott added. "If you don't want your kids to have to transition to remote learning and quarantine for a seven-day period, maybe you ought to make other plans."

THE BATTLE FOR INSECT SUPREMACY

Invasive keyhole wasp builds nests in aircraft instruments, may pose 'significant risk' to air safety

The study, due to be published in the journal PLOS One today, came off the back of a series of incidents at Brisbane airport where wasp nests, constructed in an aircraft's speedometer, forced planes to abandon take-off or even turn back after departure.

A few types of nesting wasps live in the Brisbane area, but no-one knew which was responsible for cutting flights short.

The culprit — a small black wasp with yellow bands on its pointed abdomen nicknamed the keyhole wasp (*Pachodynerus nasidens*) — is a recent arrival to our shores.

Native to the Caribbean and South and Central America, it was discovered in Australia during a routine quarantine check at the Port of Brisbane in 2010, and first spotted at Brisbane Airport two years later.

It can nest in plants and in the ground, but it's named for its propensity to take advantage of artificial nooks and crannies — such as keyholes — when it builds nests.

And they can be a massive headache when they get into things like vital aircraft instruments.

Mississippi Cops Can Now Use Your Ring Doorbell Camera To Live Stream Your Neighborhood

The Jackson, Mississippi police department is piloting a 45 day program that allows them to live stream private security cameras, including Amazon Ring cameras, at the residences of its citizens.

It's no surprise that Amazon's Ring cameras were the only brand named for the pilot program, as EFF pointed out, since they have over 1,000 partnerships with local police departments.

The program allows Ring owners to patch their camera streams to a "Real Time Crime Center" - i.e. a dispatcher on desk duty whose new favorite way of passing the time is to watch you bring out your garbage twice a week in a bathrobe.

While the pilot program is supposedly "opt-in" only, meaning residents have to volunteer to be a part of it, it is an obvious step in the wrong direction of mass privacy invasion without a warrant.

The worst part is that even if you don't participate and a neighbor's cameras are pointed off center, perhaps towards a portion of your property, that footage can now be reviewed and combed through by law enforcement officials.

Police have used Ring cameras to "build comprehensive CCTV camera networks blanketing whole neighborhoods", EFF notes, reducing the hardware burden on the department and slipping their presence into a neighborhood where it may otherwise not be welcomed.

Amazon published a statement distancing themselves from the program: "[Amazon and Ring] are not involved in any way with any of the companies or the city in connection with the pilot program. The companies, the police and the city that were discussed in the article do not have access to Ring's systems or the Neighbors App. Ring customers have control and ownership of their devices and videos ,and can choose to allow access as they wish."
